Becoming Picasso (Comedy) Bonnie Maffei

When an untalented artist acquires Picasso's paintbox, his spirit appears to mentor her. Unfortunately, with Picasso's genius come his demons. It was just a normal day at Georgetown University and a day of soccer practice. But after an accident left him in a coma for three days, he displayed an ability that a particular government agency wanted at any cost. Little did he realize that his new-found power would gain him entry into the secretive Quantum Group. (Book for adaptation)

Best Before John Dorman

Mercenaries hide from their past in Mexico. As former soldiers for hire, these two Americans are revisited by their nefarious prior lives. Relationships have changed, however, bringing into question lifelong bonds, as their potential escapes expand and contract.

Her ex-lover, a cop who put the worst criminals there, goes on a mission to rescue the woman, fighting a relentless war with old and new foes.

Blood of the Patriot

Philip Sacco and Christopher Bihrle

After being incarcerated in a bunker by the NVA in 1964 Vietnam, four brave soldiers must escape their captors and hunt down the ones responsible for their torment on both sides of the battlefield.

Brian Maximus Tony Reed

Brian Maximus is a software designer by day and a paid assassin by night. His wife is brutally murdered on their 5th anniversary, only to find out she's killed by family for money.

Charlie Three Frank Hurford

Trapped within a virtual reality "experience," six college buddies struggle to escape a ruthless cyber-creature set loose by a programming glitch.

Dancing on the Mother Road

William Davis and David Beaty

Woody Guthrie would sing his way down her with songs like, "This Land Is Your Land." Will Rogers cut red, white, and blue ribbons declaring her open to the public. Roadside attractions, diners, and motels were lit in neon. Dorothea Lange would snap photographs of poverty and injustice. Pretty Boy Floyd would rob banks and use her to escape.

Dead Cargo & Family Theodore Soderberg

A sailor brings his family aboard a ship to save his marriage, amidst a zombie outbreak, and the ship's crew must fight for survival as the ship heads full speed towards the Golden Gate Bridge.

Deadly Deeds Johnny Lee Green

A Mixed Martial Arts trainer and ex-Army sergeant suffering from PTS is targeted for death by an unknown person. Meanwhile, his terminally ill sister, who was involved in a road rage incident with an unstable man, is being stalked. Bad things happen to bad people. Bad things also happen to good people.

Death at a Distance Martin Bernard Foley

A British headmaster, ex-SAS, discovers his daughters were murdered by Peru's top narcotrafficker. At the showdown, who is the more guilty, the "killer" headmaster or the "numero uno" trafficker?

Cecile Cinco Options Kids Just Wanna Have Fun

Cecile Cinco with Global Edge Productions found *Kids Just Wanna Have Fun* through InkTip and optioned it from Andrew Chisholm. This will be their third collaboration since Cecile discovered Andrew on InkTip several years ago. Her previous credits include *The Bandit Hound*, starring Judd Nelson (*The Breakfast Club*), among others. In addition to his screenwriting, Andrew is also a musician, food blogger, and teacher. This is his third success through InkTip.

Joe Lagana Hires Michael Brody

Joe Lagana with Intrinsic Value Films discovered Michael Brody on InkTip and has hired him for a second (untitled) feature project. Joe originally found Michael on InkTip earlier this year and hired him to write a biopic about Norman Mailer. Intrinsic's previous credits include *The Truth About Lies*, starring Odette Annable (*Cloverfield, Supergirl*). Michael had numerous successes through InkTip since joining ten years ago, including the action/comedy *The B-Team*, starring John Cleese and Rupert Everett.

Jeremy John Wells Options A Leg Up

Actor / Producer, Jeremy John Wells found *A Leg Up* on InkTip and optioned it from Louis Castriota. In addition to his work as a producer, Jeremy has appeared on numerous TV series alongside Michael Pena and Jessica Biel. Louis has been with InkTip for two years, and this is his first option as a result. *A Leg Up* is adapted from his book *Leg Up: The Courage to Dream*, based on his own experiences raising a child with special needs. The script was adapted by screenwriter Isabel Baldree.

Gerry Nwimo Options *Hunting Party*

Gerry Nwimo with Take the Mike Productions found *Hunting Party* on InkTip and optioned it from Jeff Folschinsky and co-writer Mark Bate. Gerry's previous credits include the award-winning dramedy *Last Call at Murray*'s, starring John Savage (*The Deer Hunter*). Jeff joined InkTip two years ago, with several produced credits already on his resume. In addition to his screenwriting, he is also a playwright and theatrical producer. This is Jeff's first option through InkTip.

INSIDE THE Mind OF A Thriller Writer

There's a standout moment in *American Violence* when criminal psychologist Dr. Amanda Tyler begins to interview death row inmate Jackson Shea. When told that Dr. Tyler has read his file, Shea coldly responds, "And what? You've read some papers. Some files some prison hack too stupid to make it on the outside wrote about me after he showed me some ink blots. You read that and think you're inside my head."

Getting inside Shea's head is just what novelist-turned-screenwriter Al Lamanda set out to do in *American Violence*, his first produced film through InkTip. The film stars two-time Academy Award nominee Bruce Dern, Kaiwi Lyman, Denise Richards, Columbus Short, Johnny Messner, Michael Paré and features reigning UFC Heavyweight Champion Stipe Miocic and New England Patriots tight end Rob Gronkowski.

Lamanda, who connected with Status Media's Lauren de Normandie through InkTip's Preferred Newsletter, asks viewers to look beyond Shea's rap sheet to learn the truth behind's Shea's actions. Rather than taking the traditional route and raising questions of Shea's guilt, the film instead serves as the brutally honest deconstruction of the tortured psyche of a murderer. As Shea explains his past, audiences are given insight into his actions, slowly learning what led him to his spot on death row. Now, just as Dr. Tyler interviewed Jackson Shea in the film, we've been given an exclusive peek inside the head of Al Lamanda to analyze the inner workings of a produced screenwriter. It's time to break out those criminal psychology skills and see what makes this InkTip writer tick.

INKTIP: Tell us about yourself. How did you get your start in screenwriting?

AL: I am primarily a novelist with about 20 published novels, with an additional 5 being released in 2018/2019. I've

always loved film and decided to take a crack at it and entered a screenplay I wrote into The Austin Film Festival where it was runner-up for best screenplay. After that, a friend of mine who owns a small production company asked me if I could write a small-budget horror film for him. We got it done and the small film actually made some money. I am agent independent at the moment and have always negotiated my own book and now film deals.

INKTIP: What was your inspiration for *American Violence*? Tell us about the film and what you'd like to share about it. Is it your first produced feature?

AL: I spent a lot of time as an investigator in New York and New England and I've always been curious as to what makes a criminal tick. No one starts out to be a criminal and I wanted to explore the other side of the coin. I wanted to write a story that wasn't so cut and dried and that showed realism on both sides of the coin, while at the same time entertaining the audience and leaving them with something to think about.

INKTIP: You and Lauren de Normandie (the producer of the film) connected over InkTip's newsletter. How was that experience? Was there a deciding factor that made you move forward with the option?

AL: Connecting with Lauren de Normande, the producer of the film

through InkTip was an absolute breeze. If I may, there are many sites that claim insight to Hollywood producers but never deliver. InkTip does and their process is simple to work with. What clicked with me and Lauren was pretty simple, she was looking for a story similar to mine, and through InkTip we contacted each other. Although I had interest from several other independent film producers, I chose to work with Lauren because she was easy to talk to and relate to and made the entire process very simple to navigate. I am very grateful to her for the opportunity and would work with her again in a heartbeat.

INKTIP: Your script was optioned in July of 2015 and released in February 2017. What was that 19-month period like for you? Any advice for other writers who've recently gotten an option?

AL: During the 19 months between option to film, I kept busy writing two new novels and another screenplay. I wasn't asked to do rewrites and Lauren and I kept in touch on a regular basis until the film was complete. My advice to writers who have recently gotten options is to not bug the people that optioned your work. They are professionals and know what they are doing. They will reach out to you with and when they have questions. Bugging them will only serves to raise your own anxiety level.

INKTIP: How do you feel about the film and seeing it on screen? Do you have a favorite scene?

AL: Seeing the film on screen at the Hollywood premiere was an amazing experience. To see and hear words you wrote acted out by such an amazing cast left an impression on me that will stay with me forever. If I have to pick one scene as a favorite it's when Michael Paré (*Eddie and the Cruisers, The Virgin Suicides, The Lincoln Lawyer*) is

introduced as the master thief. I have been a huge fan of his work for decades and to watch him act out words that I wrote simply floored me. Afterward, when we met, he is just about the nicest man you will ever want to meet.

INKTIP: How has your experience with InkTip been so far?

AL: I can honestly say that I love InkTip and will continue to be part of the family for as long as I can. I am on firstname basis with many of the people and they actually do answer emails in a timely fashion and genuinely do care about their clients. Thanks to InkTip, I do have some new fires burning, but I am not allowed to talk about them as yet. As soon as I am able, I will fill you in on the progress.

INKTIP: How did you decide to use InkTip?

AL: My decision to contact InkTip was a pretty simple one. When I had the script ready, I did my homework on sites offering the same types of service. My decision was based on which site had the highest customer satisfaction rating and I chose InkTip. In a lot of ways it's like buying a car: you go where the most customers are the most satisfied.

INKTIP: What are your favorite films and how has that influenced your writing?

AL: Some of my favorite films are *The Searchers, Shane, Bullitt, Serpico* and *Citizen Kane.* How they influenced me is that they are not just highly entertaining films, but they leave you thinking about what you've just seen. There are many films that entertain, but when the lights come on and you go home you don't give them a second thought. I want to give people a second thought while they are being entertained and afterward.

INKTIP: I see that you live in Maine. How have you been able to pursue a screen-writing career there? What unique challenges/benefits do you have?

AL: I live in Maine, but I'm from New York City. Twenty years ago it would have been more of an issue, but with email it's really no different than if I was still living in Manhattan. No one wants a hard copy in the mail anymore, so emailing documents can be done from anywhere. The one drawback is that it's a long way to the West Coast. However, where I live is a postcard setting and the serenity provides me ample opportunity for writing without the distractions of the hustle and bustle of a big city. I may have to drive ten miles to get a quart of milk, but it's a beautiful drive.

INKTIP: What's one thing you wish you knew earlier in your career?

AL: That people in the business are far more approachable than you would think. If you have a great story to tell, they will listen. But, they won't listen if you believe them unreachable.

INKTIP: Please tell us about your writing process. Do you have a writing routine? A specific way you approach a new script? How do you decide if an idea is worth pursuing and writing a script about?

AL: Writing requires discipline. It's very easy to become distracted and lose focus. I set up a routine for myself that I rarely stray from. I enter my little office around nine. Some days I spend

making notes on ideas and plot points. Other days I'll crank out ten or more pages. I approach each script or novel differently because each is a different story to tell. I try to stay away from cookie-cutter writing and clichés. I know right away if an idea is worth pursuing if it rings hollow on the page. If the writing seems false to me, the writer, it will also ring false to the reader or viewer.

INKTIP: Anything else you'd like to share?

AL: Stay true to yourself. Never try to copy someone else's style of writing. It will ring false. Develop your own style of writing and always avoid falling back on clichés. It may take a little longer to develop your own particular brand of writing, but it will come from the heart. If you believe in yourself and your talent, never give up. You will hear the word no many, many times, but it only takes one yes to open doors. You will never hear that yes if you abandon your dreams and talent. Perseverance is what makes writers.

Status Media & Entertainment is one of the many production companies that use InkTip to find scripts and writers. Status Media & Entertainment has produced 19 feature films in just the last four years. Of those 19 produced films, eight have been made from scripts and/or writers found through InkTip. One of their latest films is American Violence, written by InkTip writer Al Lamanda and produced by Lauren de Normandie, the managing member of Status Media & Entertainment. Lauren handles all business aspects of the company and serves as casting director, producer, and the head of literary acquisitions. Lauren has cast and produced more than ten feature films including the action/thriller *4GOT10* starring Dolph Lundgren and Danny Trejo (2015); the sci-fi/thriller *WEAPONiZED* (2016) starring Tom Sizemore, Johnny Messner and Mickey Rourke; and the western *Traded* (2016) starring Kris Kristofferson, Michael Pare and Trace Adkins.

Lauren was looking for a crime thriller script and sent out a request for scripts in InkTip's Preferred Newsletter. She came across Al's query and they connected. She liked his unique thriller that took on the nuanced issue of the death penalty and told a compelling story. She optioned the script and then bought it. *American Violence* opened in select U.S. theaters in February of this year.

American Violence tells the story of a psychologist fascinated by the root causes of violent behavior who interviews a death row inmate and must determine his fate. The film stars two-time Academy Award nominee Bruce Dern, Kaiwi Lyman, Denise Richards, Columbus Short, Johnny Messner, Michael Paré and features reigning UFC Heavyweight Champion Stipe Miocic and New England Patriots tight end Rob Gronkowski. You can see the film on Netflix, Amazon Video, Google Play, Vudu, iTunes, YouTube, and it's also available on DVD and Blu-ray.

Lauren is currently developing several projects, including *Gangster Land* starring *Hacksaw Ridge*'s Milo Gibson and written by InkTip writer Ian Patrick Williams. Lauren took time from her busy schedule to chat with us about *American Violence* and her experiences as a producer.

INKTIP: How did you get your start in the industry?

LAUREN: I actually got my start sort of by accident. I was working in publicity when I met my partner Timothy. He was doing more acting than directing/producing at the time. We started talking about what it would be like to work on our own projects and have complete

creative control, and before we knew it we'd started our own company.

INKTIP: I heard you found the script for *American Violence* through InkTip's newsletter. What about Al's query stood out to you? Any advice for writers who are querying producers?

LAUREN: I was really intrigued by Al's query. The death penalty is a really fascinating and polarizing issue, and very relevant today. I thought it would be a really interesting idea to try and show the story of someone on death row from their perspective. Once I had a chance to dive into the script, I really felt for Jack (the main character on death row).

My advice for writers who are querying producers is to let your work speak for itself, and try not to be too pushy. If your script is something that we think will be a good fit for us, we will reach out! And remember, producers get sent hundreds of logline and scripts every week. As much as we'd love to read all of them, there just aren't enough hours in the day. We have to be very picky with what we choose to read. I'd love to discuss every element of every script with writers and talk about how things can be improved/adjusted, etc., but that's just not feasible. I guess my point is be patient.

INKTIP: What do you look for in a script as a producer?

LAUREN: The biggest two things I look for when reading a script are character and character. As cool as a script's concept might be, if the characters aren't fleshed out and interesting it's hard to justify getting behind it, not to mention how hard it

is to interest actors when characters are flat and one-dimensional. Al's script had really amazing characters. Jack was incredibly interesting and had a great history. Although, I think my favorite character was Biggs played by Michael Pare. What an interesting guy! A degenerate gambling second-story thief with a heart of gold and a soft spot for a struggling young man just out of prison.

INKTIP: *American Violence* tackles the controversial issues surrounding the death penalty. What inspired you to tackle this difficult subject?

LAUREN: We tried to leave the film open-ended, in my opinion, not really swaying for or against the death penalty. Our goal was more to make people take a second and think about it. Starting a dialogue is probably the most important thing to me.

INKTIP: Anything you'd like to share about your experience making this film?

Was there anything interesting or funny that happened during production?

LAUREN: It was a pretty fun film to make! The cast was incredible to work with, especially our fearless Jack, Kaiwi Lyman-Mersereau. We had a great crew also. It's never a walk in the park making an independent film. It's long hours and hard work, but the crew really came together and I think we made something pretty good.

I think the funnest day on set was when Rob "Gronk" Gronkowski came to play the get-away driver. He was a blast!

INKTIP: Many of the films you've produced have been action/thrillers. What draws you to this genre?

LAUREN: First and foremost is marketability. Action/thrillers tend to appeal to the widest audiences.

Personally, I lean more towards mystery/crime/thrillers, and probably have since the first time I watched *Clue*.

INKTIP: *American Violence* is the latest in a series of projects you've found using InkTip. How would you describe your experience with InkTip so far?

LAUREN: InkTip is a great service! We've had some pretty good luck finding scripts through InkTip. It's userfriendly and straightforward. I like how you can really pin down what you're looking for with the subcategory tabs. Another really helpful feature is when you can post a notice for a very particular type of project and have writers submit, it really helps narrow things down even more, which is key when there are thousands of scripts floating around out there.

INKTIP: Do you have any tips for producers or directors using InkTip or searching for and developing content in general?

LAUREN: Know what you're looking for. If you start your search looking in every genre with no parameters or limitations, you are going to get bogged down. Narrow your search in your mind before you start, it will save you a ton of time and hair pulling.

Mort Weatherby is a quirky guy. He works in a Portland, Oregon cemetery, where the dead seem more alive to him than the living. Enter Tracy Dibble, an attractive widow, to shake up his moribund life. Little Miss Sunshine meets Harold and Maude.

Noah Jones, Gersh-LA

The Lost Army (Drama) Gary S. Chafetz

Using camels, subsurface radar, and a small airplane, a troubled novelist conducts a search in Egypt's Western Desert for a Persian army lost in a sandstorm in 525 BC. But the assassination of Egyptian president Anwar Sadat on October 6, 1981 complicates his search and alters his life. (Based on the novel, The Lost Army: The National Geographic and Harvard University Expedition, 2012.)
